ADLERBERTSKA HOSPITIEFONDEN 2011

The Sahlgrenska Academy hereby advertises funds from the Adlerbert assistance fund. Entitled to apply are the foreign visiting students within undergraduate programmes or postgraduate studies at University of Gothenburg who intend to return to their native countries after completed studies. The extent of the studies at Göteborg University should be at least three months. Foreign students who receive Swedish study loan and/or have a permanent residence permit in Sweden are not entitled to apply.

A differentiation of the amount will be made according to period of study during 2012:

Less than three months	no stipend
Three to six months	half a stipend
More than six months	whole stipend

To the application a certificate should be attached confirming that the student is registered at University of Gothenburg. The certificate should be issued by the department at which the student will be studying during the spring term 2012.

The application should be handed in personally (to the Service center at Medicinaregatan 3) by Friday the 24th of February 2012 at the latest. Applications that are handed in later will not be considered. When handing in the application the applicant must show his or her passport. The assistance funds will be paid by the SEB Enskilda Banken in late April.

The application should be made on a special form posted at the webpage www.sahlgrenska.gu.se/english/education/Grants/.
